

NET TUTOR

There are three locations within Blackboard where you can access your NetTutor portal, the Institution Page under Helpful Links, the Student Blackboard Orientation and Knowledge base, and within your courses.

1. Go to <https://online.mayvillestate.edu/>
2. Login using your user.name and password
