This report provides some information and statistics about students who graduated Spring and Summer 2023 and 2024. There is also information regarding the averages of the six divisions at Mayville State University.


Data is based on responses collected following NACE (National Association of Colleges & Employers) guidelines through electronic surveys, contacts, other sources such as LinkedIn.
